The first 190 Bentley Chassis i.e., Chassis Nos. B.1AE to B.180AH inclusive, were fitted with mild steel expansion boxes and down pipes. These boxes were subsequently manufactured from Staybright steel in order to provide immunity from burning troubles which were experienced with the mild steel box.

In cases where the exhaust system has to be dismantled in the course of any repair work the expansion box and down pipe should be examined, and, if necessary, replaced with a Staybright box.

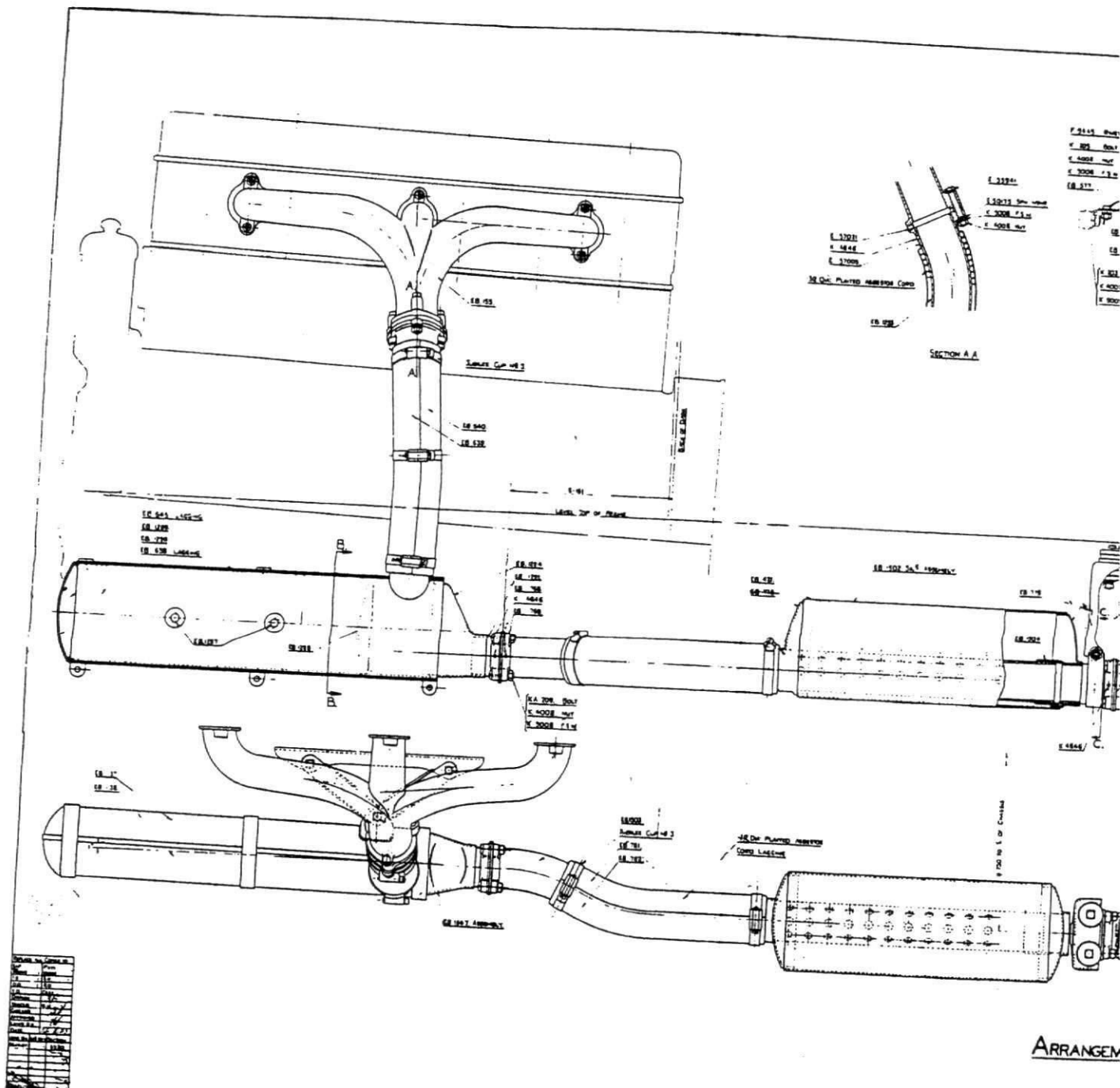
